Principal to leave for Potomac superintendent/principal job

Just weeks after hiring a new superintendent, Hoopeston Area officials will now have to find a new high school principal.

Larry Maynard, Hoopeston Area High School principal for the past 10 years, has accepted a job as Potomac Grade School superintendent/principal.

He replaces Jamie Dorsey, who is retiring after 17 years in the position.

According to news reports, Maynard was one of 20 applicants for the position. He cited the proximity to Paxton, where he and his wife live, as well as district quality and the people he will be working with as reasons he applied for the job.

While looking forward to his new position, Maynard called his 10 years at Hoopeston Area "some of the best of my life."

"I will miss working with Mr. Hornbeck, the administrative team, board of education, parents, community members, and the incredible staff and students that I have had the pleasure of working with throughout the years. I cannot thank you enough for all of the opportunities and experiences you have provided me

during my time with this district."

Before coming to Hoopeston, much of Maynard's career in education was as teacher and coach, at Eureka High School, Paxton-Buckley Loda, and Rantoul Township High School.

Maynard earned his master's degree in education administration from Eastern Illinois University and became principal of Judah Christian School, Champaign, before returning to Rantoul Township High School as dean of students/assistant principal. He served for three years before com-
