A new vice president was also named. Chris

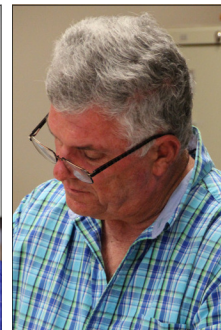
