Final arrangements have been set for Leo Huffman, 91, of Hoopeston, a longtime Hoopeston teacher, principal and superintendent.

Mr. Huffman died Friday, April 29, 2017 at his home.

A memorial service will be held at noon Saturday at First Presbyterian Church, 915 E. Orange St., Hoopeston.

Born to Arley and Lillian (Reinke) Huffman on December 18, 1925, Mr. Huffman married the former Betty Starr on December 23, 1950. She survives, along with four

Graduating in 1950 with an education degree from Bradley University, Mr. Huffman began a 35-year career with the Hoopeston School District, first as a teacher and basketball coach at Honeywell Grade School, then principal of Lincoln Grade School and John Greer Junior High. In 1965, he became superintendent, where he remained until retiring in 1985.

Mr. Huffman was a 60-year member of First Presbyterian Church, where he served nine terms as elder. He delivered Meals on Wheels for many years and was a past member of Hoopeston Rotary Club.
