• Ankenbrand also announced that Fire Chief Joel Bird has been named District 1 county board representative, replacing Darren Duncan, who was hired as county treasurer.
• Approved hiring Russell Leigh and Associates for the 2017 audit at a cost not to exceed \$6,400.
• Heard from Ald. Alex Houmes who will hold a parks committee meeting at 6:30 p.m. Tuesday to discuss camper parking in McFerren Park.
In the past, parking has been decided on a case-by-case basis, but Houmes said he would like to discuss whether to allow it, where parking would be allowed, and fees.
• Learned from Ald. Ryan Anderson that bids for the city's sidewalk program will close May 15.
• Heard from Mayor Bill Crusinberry that bids are again being sought for drainage work at the water retention lagoon behind Casey's on Rt. 9. Work includes removing vegetation and trees from the area. Bid specs are available at city hall. Bids will be opened at noon Monday, May 15. The work was previously out for bids but none were received on time, he said.
