

Two 15-year-olds arrested in separate cases

**A 15-year-old** Hoopeston boy was taken to the Juvenile Detention Center in Danville after police tried to speak to him as part of a battery investigation.

The boy was arrested at 6:37 p.m. Wednesday at Hoopeston Public Library on preliminary charges of two counts of aggravated battery to police officer and resisting arrest after he allegedly became physical with officers.

He was also charged with criminal damage to statesupported property.
