Tornado strikes Rossville, leaves Hoopeston with flooding

ROSSVILLE—After a strong storm swept through town Friday evening, residents went to church Sunday, thankful no lives had been lost, but sad at the loss to their community.

High winds toppled many stately trees, one of which broke a gas line, causing a gas leak. Winds also overturned sheds, small buildings and farm equipment, took off parts of roofs and dropped limbs on vehicles. T h e

wind also snapped electric lines, leaving the village powerless. Ameren crews worked overnight to restore power Saturday morning.

No area of Rossville was spared, as damage stretched from Mann's Chapel, through the down and up Rt. 1, where trees were damaged at Hubbard Trail Country Club.

The storm was classified as an F-1 tornado, according to information from Vermilion County Emergency Management Agency. An F-1 has wind speeds of up to 117 miles per hour.

By the time the storm hit Hoopeston, winds had lessened significantly but were still strong enough to drive hail through the windows of some homes and more than 2" of rain in about 20 minutes caused immediate flooding in many areas of town.

A town that normally welcomes visitors, Rossville officials on Friday night asked that people not drive through the village because of more than 20 Ameren crews working to restore power and the number of downed trees throughout.

Significant damage was also caused by the storm in Alvin, East Lynn and rural areas in its path.
