Porsches through the ages converge on Hoopeston Sunday

For Jim Kutill, there are similarities between owning a Porsche and marriage.

Kutill, a member of the Chicago chapter of Porsche Club of America, was one of about 60 Porsche owners who motored to Hoopeston Sunday to visit the site of the former Imported Motor Car Company of Hoopeston, at 214 E. Penn.

Kutill, of Oak Park, and his wife, Laura, married in 1978. Using half of the wedding money they received, Kutill bought a Porsche. Nearly 40 years later, "We're still married and we still have the car," he said.

Unlike most visitors to Sunday's stop in Hoopeston, Kutill didn't bring his yellow 1974 Porsche 914. Instead, he and Laura made the weekend trip in their air-conditioned Volvo.

Porsche club members started their trip Saturday, starting west of Chicago, lunching in Lena before heading to Canton. On Sunday, the group headed east on Rt. 9 to Hoopeston, where they arrived at about noon, and were given a police escort up Market Street to Penn, where drivers parked their Porsches four abreast to fit them all

between Bank and Market streets.

Club members toured the former Imported Motor Car Company - formerly Neal Tire and now Hoopeston Jax Wax and Auto Detailing - where they took advantage of air conditioning and bathrooms before heading to Pontiac for a tour of the Route 66 Museum before returning to the Chicago area.

Some Hoopeston residents toured the building, too, unaware of its history as a former import dealership, complete with elevator for moving cars.

Imported Motor Car Company of Hoopeston was started by Ed Trego Jr. in 1950, one of four foreign car dealerships in the entire United States at that time.

Trego, who owned Hoopeston Canning Company, sold the business to Stokely Van Camp and bought an MG TC, then an MG T series Midget, and then a Jaguar Mark V.

As the company grew, it attracted publicity and customers through its record in road races throughout the country.

Trego sold the company to John Shakespeare, whose father started the Shakespeare Fishing Tackle Company and who owned Shakespeare Products, which make auto cables, and Shakespeare Oil Company in Centralia. Shakespeare eventually moved the venture to Danville.

As part of the motoring weekend, the Porsche club held was holding a photo contest. In Hoopeston, club members took pictures of the Porphes, the people and the surroundings.

Club member Pat Yanahan called the event a success. "We're very lucky," he said. "There've been no tickets and no accidents."
