Mark Drollinger, Hoopeston police chief loses cancer battle

"Be kind to one another." Hoopeston Police Chief Mark Drollinger said those

words many times, both in person and on Facebook.

Over the last many months, people have shown how kind they can be, offering prayers and support during his battle with oral can-

At 6:54 a.m. Thursday, after a hard-fought battle, Chief Drollinger lost that battle.

In March 2016, Chief Drollinger was diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer of the mandibule (jaw), news that he shared on Facebook.

Since then, the chief took Mark Drollinger as grand marshall of the 2016 National his story to a wider audi-Sweetccorn Festival Parade. ence, doing interviews with

area papers, radio stations and television stations to spread the word about oral cancers.

On July 9, 2016, Chief Drollinger underwent surgery to remove a tumor and his right jawbone, replacing it with part of his right tibula.

Surgery was followed by radiation and chemotherapy at the Carle Cancer Center in Danville. In March, Chief Drollinger and Susie Ward traveled to the Taussig Cancer Institute in Cleveland, Ohio, hoping for a miracle.

Chief Drollinger lost his hair, but not his sense of humor. He was determined to live not as a cancer victim but as someone living with cancer. The song "Live Like You Were Dying" by Tim McGraw's became his mantra. He continued to work light duty as he was able. On St. Patrick's Day, he married Ward, whom he considered his best friend and soul mate.

Also in March, the couple went on an extended southern vacation, including New Orleans, a place Chief Drollinger loved so much, he christened his local home The Redneck Ouarter reminders of the French Ouarter in New Or-

In April, friends, family and colleagues gathered at Hoopeston American Legion for a party with the chief. On April 22, he celebrated his 54th birthday with friends and golf-

Chief Drollinger's fight carried on, taking a heavier toll.

Trips to the police station became fewer and of shorter duration, as he allowed Sgt. Jim DeWitt to take on some of the responsibility.

It was only at the last, as the pain intensified, that Chief Drollinger was placed in hospice care and took advantage of the pain relief available through that program.

Last weekend, to honor the man who been Hoopeston Police Chief since January 5, 1999, businesses and organizations with outdoor signs honored Chief Drollinger for his service, with variations of "Thanks, Chief" throughout Hoopeston.

Funeral arrangements for Chief Drollinger are pending at Anderson Funeral Home, Hoopeston.


