

Excessive heat watch in effect today through Saturday evening

The National Weather Service has issued an excessive heat watch for a large part of central Illinois, including Vermilion County, starting at noon today and ending at 8 p.m. Saturday.

Temperatures in the 90s, combined with high humidity, will create heat index values of 110-110 degrees each day, with the highest values likely Thursday and Friday.

Residents are advised to drink plenty of fluids, stay in air-conditioned rooms, stay out of the sun and check on relatives, neighbors and pets.
