Ordinance OKs part time officers, changes how chief hired

An ordinance approved 7-0 by the Hoopeston City Council allows for the hiring of part time officers and also changes how future police chiefs will be hired.

Once hired, part time officers may be used to fill in for such things as vacations and when full time officers who also serve in the military are on their military duties, said Ald. Brandon Hamilton, police committee chairman, at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting. Part time officers will supplement the department as "a helping hand," he said.

Part time officers will be hired by the police chief, with the advice and consent of the council. They must be at

least 21 years old, have proper training, and be able to pass medical, psychological and physical agility tests.

The ordinance also changes who will hire future police chiefs, moving the duty from the Hoopeston Board of Police Commission to the mayor, with the advice and

Groups sponsor town hall with 2018 gubernatorial candidate

Arneya Pawar, an alderman in Chicago's 47th Ward, hopes to be Illinois' next governor and will meet with Vermilion County residents at a town hall meeting on Saturday.

Pawar, who, according to his website, hopes to "restore progressive values" in the state, will speak briefly on his positions and take questions from the audience at the event, to start at 4:15 p.m. at the Vermilion County Democratic headquarters, 15 N. Vermilion, Danville.

Pawar's appearance is sponsored by Vermilion County Democrats and Indivisible Illinois Northern 15th. Indivisible Illinois is a predominantly Facebook-based organization that provides networking for progressive groups, predominantly in the Chicagoland area.

Following the town hall, Pawar will take part in the Three Kings of Peace march, beginning at 6 p.m. at Griffin and Williams.

Three Kings marches began in 2016 by Edward Butler, the Rev. Frank McCullough and Nathan Smalls, who led marches in various Danville neighborhoods to help reduce gang violence.

Hoopeston police chiefs had been hired by mayors until the mid- to late 1970s, when hiring was moved to the police commission.
