Lemonade stand teaches business lessons, helps animal shelter

Some local kids got a taste of the business world and helped area animals as part of a one-week class.

The class, Lemonade Stand, was the idea of Brian Fink, DACC accounting professor, who taught the class last week as part of College for Kids at the DACC Higher Learning Center in Hoopeston.

While some classes teach youngsters a skill to become employable, Lemonade Stand was designed to "show kids there's a potential in business," Fink said.

In class, Fink covered things like start-up costs, liability and net worth. He also made lemonade stands for stu-



dents, each of whom painted and decorated a stand. After the class, students were able to take their stands home.

Before the lemonade could be sold, supplies had to be purchased, so Wednesday, students went to Hoopeston IGA to buy lemons, lemonade and water, staying within the budget set for the project.

Ella Combes, Amanda Brown and Tobi West, ages 9, 12 and 11, respectively, were "That's so Lemonade!" Thursday outside the Hoopeston IGA. Their stands were festooned with streamers and Combes' featured a large pink lemon cutout, listing the prices of pink lemonade, lemonade, sweet tea and balloon animals.

Combes and Brown each wore balloon headbands while enticing passersby to purchase a drink by offering free samples.

As part of the class, students also learned food safety measures, making sure to wear gloves while handling their wares.

With a total of seven students in the class, the remain-

In class on Friday, students learned concepts behind business revenues. Each student had a binder with documentation for their business and Fink helped them develop a spreadsheet at the end of the class.

Students were not the only ones learning during the class. This was the first class that came from Fink's suggestion. During Thursday's sale, he was already planning ahead to next year and ways to improve on his idea.

It was also the first time Fink taught students in this age group. "It was quite the learning experience for him and he thoroughly enjoyed it," said Karla Coon, Hoopeston Learning Center director.

Students had decided to donate sale proceeds to Hoopeston Area Rescue Team. To allow them to donate all the money they made to HART. Coon donated the cost of supplies. From one hour of sales at both locations, students raised \$95.52 to donate to the animal care group.
