Cornjerker football gets first win on solid air, ground game

Good air and ground games propelled Hoopeston Area/Schlarman Academy/Armstrong Potomac to a 27-14 win over Martinsville Friday night.

Sophomore Marcus Blurton completed 12 of 16 passes for 124 yards, including three of the team's four touchdowns.

Adam Colunga, juniors Jacob Catron and Caleb Larkin

and sophomore Jared Kellogg each scored a TD.

Sophomore Vaughn Black added two with a conversion and junior Carson Alwardt added one with a field goal.

Leading rushers for the game were Colunga with 61, Larkin with 34 and junior Jordan Mance with 22.

Black led receiving three for 39 yards, followed by Catron with three for 28.

Colunga and Catron tied with four tackles each.

The win is the first for Trey Stille, in his first year as head coach of the HA/SA/AP co-op team.
