Businesses clean up after vandals spray paint buildings

The last thing Chago Solis needed Thursday morning was one more thing to do. The Hoopeston man works third shift at Casey's, takes care of his mother during the day and in the evenings, is the manager of Bzzz Place, a local watering hole at 306 E. Main, Hoopeston. It - along with many other buildings - was spray painted with graffiti late Wednesday night or early Thursday

morning. Solis, blue flecks of paint in his dark hair, worked hurriedly to paint over an "f bomb" painted in bright red on the blue wall. As of 10:30 a.m., Hoopeston police had received 18 reports of damage scattered throughout Hoopeston, including Hoopeston City Hall, where a wall and windows were tagged.

Two Hoopeston women report thefts of home safes, valuables

Police said Watson was stopped in traffic at Main and Bank when Napier hit the rear of her vehicle.

Vandals evaded surveillance cameras at some locations, but may not have been so fortunate at others, as several local businesses have security cameras for just such incidents.

Vandals painted both occupied and vacant buildings, including the former Grant Township building, with green paint on the doors and black on the building, as well as the former Subway building downtown.

Damage was not contained to the downtown area, as the VFW, at 428 W. Orange, was also hit. Garages and residences were also reported painted.
