And the walls came tumbling' down

Quick council action results in quicker work on collapsed downtown building

Action taken at a special council meeting on October 30 resulted in a quick start on taking down a dilapidated building at 105 E. Main.

Once council approval was given for contractor the work, an Illinois EPA permit - which required an application postmarked 24 hours before demolition began - was sent to Springfield, allowing Glynn Demolition to begin their work on Wednesday.

In removing that building, extensive damage was able to be viewed on the adjacent building, the former Brianna's Baby Shop, where ceiling supports had given way and the interior brick wall crumbled.

Hoopeston City Council is set to discuss demolishing that building, at 107 E. Main, at its meeting Tuesday evening.

With the building's downfall on Wednesday, Main Street was reopened to traffic. On Thursday and Friday, Terry Glynn and his crew became the task of removing debris from the site as Hoopeston street and alley workers brought loads of dirt and clay to help fill in the area.

In the future, the council may have to decide the fate of some other downtown buildings which have deteriorated.
