## County clerk faces challengers, others unopposed for primary

Vermilion County voters will have few races in the April 23, 2018 general primary election. Filings closed at 5 p.m. Monday. The election will be March 20, 2018.

Two Democrats-Mary Catherine Roberson and Darin Wayne Holycross - have filed to run for Vermilion County Clerk. Incumbent Republican Cathy Jenkins has also filed to retain her seat.

For other county offices, incumbents have filed, including:

- Matthew R. Long, Republican, supervisor of assessments.
- Pat Hartshorn, for sheriff. The Republican has

held the office for more than 25 years.

- Cheryl S. Reifsteck, Republican, regional school superintendent
- Darren E. Duncan, Republican, appointed treasurer in April after long-time treasurer Sue Stine retired, is running for his first full term.
- County Board District 1 representatives Joel Bird, Todd Johnson and Larry Baughn Jr., all Republicans, are seeking reelection.

The three, along with Duncan and Richard Thompson, have all filed to retain their positions as Republican precinct committeemen.

Although county school superintendents would like to see a referendum for a 1% sales tax on the March ballot, referenda do not have to be certified until January.

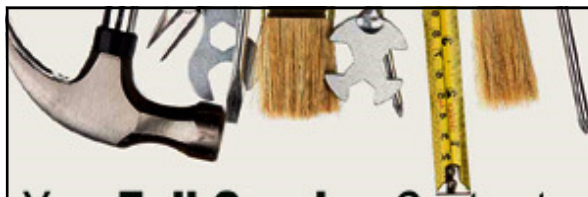
