Visitation for Warren W. Harms Jr., 52, of Hoopeston, formerly of Chicago Heights, will be noon until the 1 p.m. memorial service Saturday at Blurton Funeral Home, Hoopeston. Mr. Harms was cremated.

Memorials are suggested to the family of Denise Ried.

The son of Warren and Evelyn Harms, he is survived by his wife, Jerri; daughters, Miranda and Jamie, of Hoopeston; son Justin Smothers, of Hoopeston, six grandchildren, two brothers; and three sisters.

Mr. Harms was pronounced dead at the scene of a head-on accident at 6:21 p.m. February 7 on Rt. 1 at County Road 3870 after his vehicle crossed the center line and struck a vehicle driven by Denise Ried, of Wellington. Mrs. Ried was airlifted to Carle Foundation Hospital where she later died of her injuries.

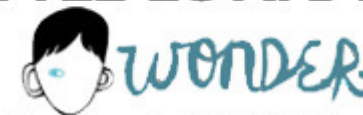
