# Student's verbal threat results in police presence at HAMS

A Hoopeston Area police officer was assigned to Hoopeston Area Middle School Friday after a 12-year -old student made a threat Thursday afternoon.

The nature of the verbal threat was not disclosed. In separate written statements, both Supt. Suzzette Hesser and James DeWitt, acting police chief, said no students or staff were in danger.

"All threats to our students, faculty, and schools are taken seriously, investigated thoroughly, and disci-

plined to the fullest extent possible in conjunction with the local police department," Hesser's statement said.

DeWitt said the police department was working with the school district, state's attorney's office and the family of the student to resolve the incident.
