Money management workshops for adults, teens set in city

In life, there are doctors for many kinds of health: physicians for physical health, psychologists for emotional health, nutrition experts for dietary issues.

But when it comes to financial health, people are pretty much on their own.

Danville Area Community College's Higher Learning Center and Tim George of Credit Union 1 have set a series of workshops to help people get and maintain financial health.

"Keeping Your Life Balanced...Money Management for Teens and Adults" workshops will be held from 6-7 p.m. Tuesday, April 17, Thursday, April 26, Thursday, May 10 and Tuesday, May 22.

In each workshop, George, manager of Credit Union 1 in Danville, will focus on helping participants balance their lives by balancing their finances. He will cover money balancing basics, the importance of credit worthiness, lessons learned from others' mistakes and identity protection.

By getting a handle on - or getting off on the right foot of - money management, people can save themselves several thousands of dollars over the course of their lives by avoiding extra charges, such as overdraft fees. George said overdraft fees at one local bank averaged \$35,000 to \$45,000 per month.
