First Farmers establishes agriculture scholarship at DACC

First Farmers Bank & Trust established a new scholarship for students in an agriculture program. The award is \$2,000 per academic year - \$1,000 each semester - and may be used for tuition, books, and fees.

The First Farmers branch in Hoopeston contacted the DACC Foundation, expressing interest in starting a scholarship. After working with Foundation staff, it was determined that criteria would include those students with low to moderate income, as defined by Pell Grant eligibility, who are pursuing a degree in agriculture. Secondary consideration will be given to those in business majors if no qualified ag applicant can be found.

"We are so grateful to First Farmers Bank & Trust for establishing a scholarship to help DACC students realize their educational dreams," said DACC Foundation Executive Director Tracy Wahlfeldt. "They are another shining example of the Hoopeston area creating opportunities for area students."
