# NWS, VCEMA weather spotter training set Thursday in Tilton

The National Weather Service, in conjunction with Vermilion County Emergency Management Agency, will conduct a Severe Weather Spotters Training Class at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, April 5 at the Tilton Community Center, 612 W. 5th St. Doors open at 6 p.m.

This class is instructed by meteorologist(s) from the National Weather Service office in Lincoln, and is for experienced storm spotters to maintain their qualification as a Certified Weather Spotter. It is also open to the general public for those who would like some severe weather training. Local EMA personnel will be on hand to answer local-based questions on severe weather reporting and procedures.

The class will be approximately 2.5 - 3 hours long. No reservations needed.

Severe storm spotters are a vital part of the warning process! Spotters provide critical, potentially lifesaving information to their communities and surrounding locations and to NWS forecasters who use the reports to help issue warnings and keep the public updated during severe weather events.

Anyone with an interest is welcome to attend a spotter class. Children (under the age of 18) are welcome to attend the class, however, they will not be considered official spotters. There is no cost for this training, just your time for the class.

Training is comprised of all of the information that spotters need to be effective and stay safe.
