## History of Hoopeston downtown to be featured in HPL walk

Small town downtowns all have a story to tell. The story of Hoopeston's Main Street will come alive later this month with a walking tour presented by the Hoopeston Public Library.

"Main Street, 1871-Present" is an hour-long walking tour of downtown which will be conducted by Tom Sweeney and Marilyn Tyler.

During the presentation, participants will learn about the history of the downtown buildings, and hear stories of days gone by, all taken from the library's archives.

Area residents have three opportunities to enjoy this free program. The tour will be presented at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Thursday, April 26, and again at 1 p.m. on Saturday, April 28.

There is limited space per group, so interested persons must sign up no later than Tuesday, April 24, at the library's main desk. Participants must be able to walk and stand during the one-hour event, and will be asked to sign a liability waiver before they can attend.
