Treasurer announces 2017 tax bills coming on time this year

Vermilion County Treasurer Darren Duncan announced last week that 2017 real estate tax bills were mailed Friday, May 4.

Taxpayers will have until June 15, which is about 45 days, to make the first installment of taxes. The second installment will be due September 4.

State statute dictates that tax bills should be mailed in early May. For several years the county treasurer's office, was unable to do so. "I am pleased to announce that we will meet that goal this year," Duncan said.

With the on-time billing, property owners will have a wider window to pay their real estate taxes with nearly three months between the installment due dates.

This will also allow the treasurer's office to make timely distributions to the taxing bodies of Vermilion County, including but not limited to, many cashstrapped school districts.

"It is planned that our office will be able to maintain this schedule consistently in coming years so that tax payers as well as taxing districts know what to plan towards, Duncan said.

Some ways to pay tax bills include:

- •paying online under the Treasurer's tab on the county website, vercounty.org:
- •in person at the Vermilion County Administration Building:
- •mailing payment to the PO box listed on the tax bill payment coupon;
- •or at most county banks.
