get this assistance approved for the people of these counties."

People and businesses in those three counties, plus the surrounding counties of Champaign, Douglas, Edgar, Ford, Grundy, Livingston, and Will are eligible to apply for low interest, long-term loans to assist with recovery efforts.

The SBA declarations require at least 25 homes and/or businesses in a county to suffer major uninsured losses of 40% or more. The SBA's damage assessment noted 74 homes and nine businesses in Iroquois County that met that standard, along with 28 homes and three businesses in Kankakee County, in addition to 21 homes and seven businesses in Vermillion County.
