## **Grant-Butler assessor advises proof needed for exemption**

Some property owners may have gotten sticker shock when they opened their new property tax bill.

Senior citizens who previously had the senior citizens assessment freeze may have found the exemption missing from their bills.

Susie Ward Drollinger, Grant-Butler assessor, said Matt Long, Vermilion County Supervisor of Assessments, has changed some things and residents must show proof to receive the exemption.

To get the exemption reinstated, taxpayers must provide proof of income with their most current tax return. Proof of identification is also required.

Residents may take their documents to the Grant

Township office, 525 S. Market, to be copied, Drollinger said, adding residents should check their tax bills before paying to make sure they are receiving the correct exemptions.
