Klaber replaces first-year principal Marc Campbell who resigned to become superintendent of New Holland-Middleton Elementary school district next school year.

White replaces Anne Burton, who announced KLABER

her resignation in March, cited wanting a career change and to spend more time with family. Burton had been with the district for 11 years.

Both White and Klaber most recently served as student support services coordinators before being named principals. Klaber at the middle school and White at the high school. Both will begin their new duties July 1.


