Pool to open Saturday, swimming extended through September

Hoopeston swimmers will be able to hit the water starting Saturday.

Ald. Alex Houmes, parks committee chairman, announced Tuesday that Hoopeston's swimming pool and splash pad will open to the public at noon Saturday. As tradition, it will be a free swim day for everyone.

Due to the late start, the swim season will be extended through September 30, he added.

To make up for the late start, season passes will be sold at half price and can be purchased at any time after the opening. Prices are:

July 7 through August 20

- Season passes half off

- Day passes \$4
- Hours: Sunday-Saturday, 12-7 p.m. with adults only swim 6-7 p.m.

August 20-September 30

- Day passes \$2 weekdays, \$4 Saturdays and Sundays
- Hours: Monday-Friday 4-7 p.m. No dedicated adult swim.

- Saturday-Sunday noon-7 p.m., adult swim 6-7 p.m.

Season pass prices (reflecting 50 percent discount)

- 1 person \$45
- 2 person \$60
- 3 person \$75
- 4 person \$90
- 5 person \$105

Each additional person \$15

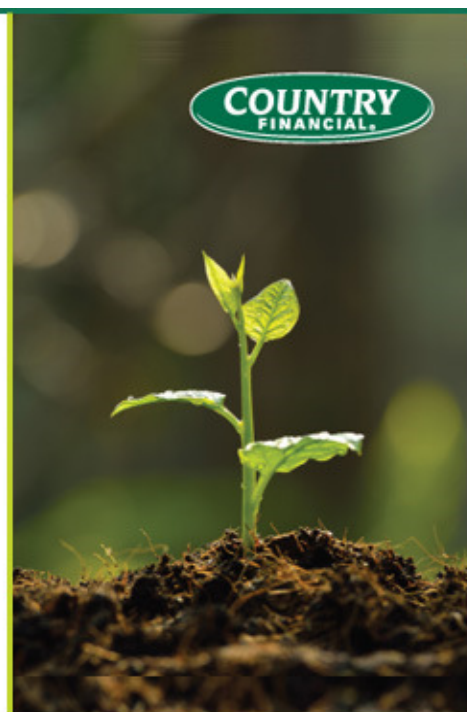
