# Master naturalist course teaches about nature, conservation

Do you have a desire to protect the natural areas found within your community? Are you happiest when you're out in nature?

Come join East Central Illinois Master Naturalists, where there are opportunities to learn, teach and improve Illinois' natural history, environment and conservation. Master Naturalists are actively engaged with nature, from gathering prairie seeds to giving tours, trail stewarding to collecting data on wildlife populations and much more.

East Central Illinois Master Naturalist (ECIMN) Program is sponsored by University of Illinois Extension, Champaign County Forest Preserve District, Champaign Park District and Urbana Park District. It is available to all residents of Central Illinois. Any adult can join EC- IMN and become a Master Naturalist through training, which will be held this fall.

U of I Extension Horticulture Educator Ryan Pankau organizes training and feels it offers valuable education to participants. "The Master Naturalist course offers members of the central Illinois community an opportunity to learn about Illinois ecosystems from experts that study them in the field," he said.

The program will kick off with a welcome party on August 14. Classes will be on Tuesdays and cover topics including nature interpretation, botany, mammalogy, grasslands, river exploration, climatology and much more. Saturday field trips to the Don Gardner Prairie in
