"Thunder in the Corn" is a truck and tractor pull sponsored by Hoopeston Area FFA Alumni.

And there will be fire in the sky following the pull with Hoopeston's annual fireworks display, sponsored by Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center and Heritage Health. Fireworks will be lit from

the soccer field and will be visible in the annex for fans to watch.

Gates open at 4 p.m. Saturday for the pull, which kicks off at 5:30 p.m. Unlike many pulls, the \$12 admission gets event-goers in the gate and

gives access to all pit areas.

Attendees are encouraged to Ryan Anderson's tractor,  $\checkmark$ 'N Out, will be one of the pullers at Saturday's "Thunder check out the trucks and tractors and talk to the pull-

ers who are competing.

Children five and younger will be admitted free.

The Lucas Oil Pro Pulling League event will feature classes 9300 lb., super farm tractors, limited pro stock tractors, pro modified 4WD trucks and pro stock diesel trucks.

Ryan Anderson, one event organizer, has pulled competitively since 2006 and is part of the Lucas Oil Pro Pulling League. He was instrumental in getting the Lucas Oil involved in the local pull, which will be a part of the PPL series. He estimated 80 to 100 competitors will take part in the event.

Previously, Hoopeston Area FFA and Rossville

Civic Club held an annual tractor pull. However, when Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning formed a cooperative high school, Hoopeston Area began planning its own event.
