Grant Township to fund stone repair, restoration at Red Top

An historic cemetery is getting a makeover, thanks to Grant Township officials.

Red Top Cemetery, which is under the township's care, will undergo restoration of its gravestones, some which are now unreadable. Helen Wildermuth and her Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration, Inc., crew were selected to do the work.

Nashville, Ind.-based Stonehugger has a long history of renovations of historic cemeteries, not only in its home state, but also in Illinois, Colorado, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, Iowa and Wisconsin.

Megan Deck, Grant Township Supervisor, said restoring the cemetery, which has been in existence since 1855,

had been discussed by the board for a while and repairs were done as finances allowed. "We have been restoring a stone here and there over the years," she said.

After receiving a \$16,000 estimate to repair about 30 gravestones, Deck started researching companies for price comparisons, but also for those specializing in restoration. "I ran across Stonehugger and Helen came to look at the cemetery and evaluated what services she had to offer," she said.

Stonehugger's estimate of \$36,950 "is costly," Deck admitted, "but in the long run, it will save us." The estimate includes resetting and cleaning 60 tablets, resetting the base, cleaning and mortaring 30 monuments, resetting, cleaning and mortaring 14 large monuments, resetting cleaning and mortaring one extra-large monument and resetting the base, cleaning and mortaring five granite stones. There are also 12 footstones and 10 tablets that will be cleaned.

Stonehugger takes before and after pictures of its work and will put them in a binder for the township to have.

In total, 132 markers will be restored and preserved. Deck said Findagrave.com indicates there are 240 graves at Red Top, but not all are marked. The cemetery includes a Potter's Field, for people who could not afford a proper burial and there is an unmarked area in the cemetery, as well.

Trustees approved the project last year, to be done in this fiscal year. Work is expected to be done this month. Grant Township is responsible for routine maintenance
