## Foodmobile to be at McFerren Park Saturday morning

Eastern Illinois Foodbank will distribute a truckload of food to area families. Distribution will be held at McFerren Park Civic Center in Hoopeston from 10-11:30 a.m. Saturday. All Vermilion County residents who meet income eligibility criteria are welcome (see chart).

Those attending are asked to bring boxes or bags to transport food.

The distribution is part of the foodbank's Foodmobile Program, a system of mobile food pantries that bring food to areas of chronic or extreme need.

Through the program, local companies and organi-

zations are invited to contribute toward a one-day distribution of food and optionally participate in the distribution process. The cost to partner with the Foodbank on a foodmobile distribution is \$3,000.

All eligible residents of Vermilion County who are in need of food and grocery product are welcome to attend the Foodmobile distribution.

To be eligible, a household must have an income at or below 185% of the federal poverty level, or approximately \$3,793 per month for a family of four.
