City council approves Teasdale request to close Lincoln St.

In a 7-1 vote Tuesday, Hoopeston City Council approved a request from Teasdale Foods to close Lincoln St. from First Ave. to the railroad tracks.

Approval was based on a recommendation from Hoopeston's planning/zoning commission, which unanimously approved the request at a meeting July 16.

Ald. Carl Ankenbrand cast the only no vote, saying at the planning meeting, a couple sitting in front of him shook their heads in disagreement at many things that were said at that meeting. They said there was no point in speaking up because the issue had already been decided, Ankenbrand said at the council meeting. "I'm going to vote 'no' for them." he said.

In approving the ordinance vacating the street, Teasdale Foods must agree to pay the city \$5,000 to cover administrative and legal fees and purchase highway signs that will direct truck traffic down Second Ave., rather than First Ave., which is now often used.

Teasdale must also install a new sidewalk south of Maple St., from First Ave. to the rail racks and cap and abandon the water main at First Ave., running under their proposed construction. Currently not in use, "it's a water main that serves nobody," said Mayor Bill Crusinberry.

Guardrails will be placed at the railroad track, the cost of which will be reimbursed by CSX, he said.

Addressing Teasdale's request - made for employee safety and also to expand the company's dock area to handle increased business - Crusinberry said he tested one concern residents expressed: that closing Lincoln would cause an inconvenience to those who lived in the area, increasing the time it took to get to their homes.

Crusinberry said he tested that, driving 18 m.p.h. from Second Ave. to a point across the tracks, which took about 35 seconds. Going from the same starting point to Penn and across the tracks to starting point took 1:48 seconds. One minute and thirteen seconds "is not a lot of inconvenience" to accommodate a local business that is growing. School district and hospital aside, Teasdale is "the one place that has created jobs in the last five years," he said.

Crusinberry added that he doesn't want Hoopeston to be known as a "city that does something only when someone threatens to leave us."

Additionally, he talked about Teasdale being a better community partner than its predecessor, Hoopeston Foods. Since taking ownership, "Teasdale stepped up and done what was asked of them and more," he said, adding Teasdale has also committed spend \$425,000 to dredge the treatment lagoon.


