Local club formed to give back closing for lack of members

A club formed with the mission of caring for the community has disbanded because not enough people cared to join.

Hoopeston Patriot's Club incorporated in July 2017 after the national VFW combined the men's and women's auxiliaries. The men's auxiliary decided to form a new group, Hoopeston Patriot's Club, to help not only the VFW Auxiliary, but also community groups that help

others, such as Grant Township Food Cupboard, Hoopeston Multi Agency and others.

In August, club President David Lucht announced the club would be closing, with the action finalized this month.

Several local people have served in leadership positions in the club, including Tammy Tetzloff, vice president and chaplain; Lori Pajor, secretary; Brenda Jones, treasurer; Ethel Lucht, guard; and trustees Stan Swartz, Chuck Hoffman and Larry Chaffee.

"We appreciate all of the help, support and interest we had for the club," Lucht said. "We also appreciate everyone who supported our breakfasts."

State Line Riders of Illinois will hold a Big Breakfast to raise additional funds from 6 a.m.-noon Saturday, Nov. 3 at Hoopeston VFW. A 50/50 drawing and VFW Auxiliary bake sale will also be held. Advance tickets will be \$5 and \$6 at the door, Lucht said.
