The Vermilion County Clerk's Office does not it ever call you to ask you to register to vote.

These calls raise the possibility of voter confusion activity, Jenkins said in a press release.

Those who provide infor-

mation to the callers will not be registered to vote, potentially causing a large number of unregistered residents to appear at their local polling place on Election Day. "We encourage any resident that has received such a phone call to report it to our office immediately," Jenkins said.

In addition, voter registration requires residents to provide significant personal information; such as date of birth, physical address, or partial Social Security numbers.

It is unclear at this time if the callers requested sensitive personal information required for registration. If
