Two Hoopeston Area Board of Education members elected in 2007 are bowing out.

Current President Mark Schaumburg and Secretary Chris Elliott will not run in the April 2, 2019 consolidated election.

A third incumbent, Chris Small, will run to retain his seat. Small, who was first elected in 2011, is the board's current vice president.

All are four-year terms.



Those interested in running for the school board may pick up nominating packets at the Vermilion County Clerk's office, located on the first floor at 201 N. Vermilion St., Danville.

Petitions became available to circulate on September 18. They must be filed December 10-17, also at the Vermilion County Clerk's office.

According to the Illinois School Code, to be on a school board, each member, shall: on the day elected, shall be a citizen of the United States, age of 18 years or older: be a resident of the State and territory of the district for at least one year immediately preceding the election; be a registered voter as provided in the general election law; not be a school trustee; must not have been removed from a school board pursuant to Section 2-3.25f-5 of this Code (unless subsequently appointed as a member of an Independent Authority or if it has been 10 years since the abolition of the Independent Authority in the district), and; not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code of 2012.
