# Widespread storm brings first major snowstorm of season

A storm system provided a weekend workout for much of the U.S., including Hoopeston.

A major winter storm buffeted central Illinois Saturday, dropping eight inches of snow on Hoopeston, while Jacksonville had 13" by noon and ended with 15" total.

Hoopeston was on top of the storm, activating snow routes shortly after 8 p.m. Friday. City crews plowed streets throughout Saturday, getting major arteries and side streets passable. Snow removal providers - both

Hoopeston police reported one accident Saturday evening but did not indicate it was caused by the weather.

That was not true at the state level, however, as Illinois State Police posts reported hundreds of accidents across Illinois.

ISP District 10 at Pesotum took to social media Friday, advising motorists to #stayhomesaturday in anticipation of winter storm Gia.

On Saturday, ISP posts detailed accidents, including a semi rollover between Tilton and Oakwood on I-74, numerous slide-offs and many fender benders.

As the snow kept falling and vehicles kept wrecking, Ashkum's ISP District 21 joined the social media posting, asking college students and parents of college students to postpone their return to central and southern Illinois colleges until Sunday, by which time the roads would be cleared.

The first part of this week is forecast to be dry but a chance of precipitation returns at week's end with a possible rain/snow Thursday night and a chance of snow Friday and Saturday.
