Hesser, Hoopeston Area to part ways at school year's end

Hoopeston Area schools and the district superintendent will part ways at the end of the school year.

At a special meeting Sunday night, the board approved a mutual separation agreement although Hesser's name was not part of the official action.

On a motion from board President Mark Schaumburg and seconded by Lawrence Jahn, the board voted unanimously to accept the agreement.

A press release issued after the meeting said both Hesser and the board decided to end their contractual relationship on June 30.

The board and Hesser met in the district office at 7:30 p.m. Sunday. The board immediately went into closed session and Hesser left the conference room, going to her adjacent office.

At about 8 p.m., Hesser returned to the conference room and shortly after, the board came out of executive session and approved the separation agreement. The meeting adjourned at 8:22 p.m.


