

Program outlining the prophecy of Passover set for April 7

First Church of God will host a program showing how the Jewish Passover was God's way of revealing Christ.

Lisa Weisbaum, of Jews for Jesus, will present "Christ in the Passover" at 6 p.m. Sunday, April 7 at the church, 1004 E. Orange St., Hoopeston.

Weisbaum will describe elements of the Passover meal, demonstrating how God was prophesving and revealing Christ more than 1,000 years before His birth and giving people a picture of how man's redemption would take place.

Weisbaum will set a table with items traditionally used at the Passover and detail their spiritual significance. She will also explain the connection between the first Passover

in Egypt and Jesus' redemption, as well as the bond between the ancient Passover feast and the Christian communion celebration today. Jesus' last supper was actually a Jewish Passover.

Pastor David Bowen is excited about the presentation, especially the learning of how the Passover foreshadows Christ. "It's history, prophecy and meaning rolled into one 60-minute, multi-sensory presentation," he said. "It will give a freshness and deeper meaning to each believer who engages to learn."

Weisbaum is a missionary at the Florida branch of Jews for Jesus. She retired from a 29-year career with the New


