## Only HA school board race is contest in Tuesday elections

Area residents will head to the polls Tuesday to select municipal and school board candidates.

Voters in the Hoopeston Area district have the choice of four candidates for two seats in the district area inside the congressional township. Additionally, two candidates are running for the area outside the congressional town-

In-township candidates include incumbent Chris Small and challengers Connie Catron. Lee Cox and Dave McFadden.

Current board President Mark Schaumburg did not seek reelection to his in-township seat.

In the area outside the township, board Secretary Chris Elliott did not seek re-election, leaving an open field for newcomers Rich Eisenman, of the rural Cissna Park area, and JoHanna Gash, of Wellington.

In the Rossville-Alvin district, three incumbents are running for four openings. Jeremy Deck, Robert Danner and Kyle Zarate will keep their seats and a fourth member will have to be found.

Milford is one short on candidates for the Milford Area Public School Board. Only three candidates - Mindy Hagan, James E. Kunce and Mary Ronna - are running for four seats.




