### Robert Richardson named HA superintendent; to start July 1

Robert Richardson said he'll bring "honest, ethical hard work" and a sense of humor to his new position as superintendent of Hoopeston Area schools.

Richardson was hired by unanimous vote at a special meeting Tuesday evening - the first major vote for new members Lee Cox, Dave McFadden and Rich Eisenmann, who were seated at the meeting.

"I feel like a high school kid who's just signed a letter of intent," Richardson said after the vote. He praised those in the district whom he has met as "a bunch of fun-loving people but they get things done."

After the meeting, the 48-year-old described himself as "a 'boots on the ground' kind of guy. I like to pitch in and get my hands dirty."

For Richardson, the move is about numbers. The first number is district size.

For the last three years, he has been superintendent at Brimfield, a 700-student district 25 miles west of Peoria. "This is a bigger place," he said. Hoopeston Area's enrollment is more than 1,200, according to the district's Illinois Schools Report Card.

The second number is administration. In his first year at Brimfield, Richardson served as superintendent and principal. This year, the bookkeeper left in August "so I was that, as well," he said. Hoopeston Area has wellestablished staff in the necessary positions, he said.

The final number is salary. Richardson and the board agreed on a two-year contract with an annual base of \$120,000, up slightly from the \$115,164 listed on the Brimfield website for Richardson's salary for the 2017-18

Born in Hindsboro, Richardson said he decided to become an educator "late in life," starting college at age 28. He earned a Master's degree in Educational Leadership and Administration from Eastern Illinois University and a Master's degree in Plant and Soil Science and Agricultural Education from Southern Illinois University.

His first job post-college was as ag teacher at Maroa-Forsyth. He was there from 2003-06. He then served as


