don building at 210 S. Market. The building, owned by Save the Lorraine Foundation, is being renovated to provide affordable space to local small businesses. Sculpt occupies the ground floor, which needed a little sculpting of its own to transform from a bank into a fitness center.

Sculpt offers cardio, strength, free-weights and power lifting equipment and classes focused on cardiovascular, function, strengthening and endurance.

The fitness center is staffed Monday-Saturday but members have 24/7 access.

Before opening their venture, the women sought guidance from the SBDC at DACC. "There's no manual for starting your own business in the state of Illinois," Moore said at that time. "They kept us on the right path."
