Property tax bills mailed; first installment due June 1: treasurer

Vermilion County tax bills are in the mail!

Treasurer Darren Duncan announced Wednesday that real estate tax bills have been mailed. Taxpayers have until June 14 - which is 30 days - to make their first installment payment. The second installment is due September 6.

Despite being delayed for 40 days by the Illinois Department of Revenue, by working with the county clerk and assessor's offices, "we have been able to turn around

Drollinger's office will handle tax bills and exemption forms this year on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 8 a.m.-noon. Taxpayers who have questions may call her office at 283-6868.

the bills quickly and still mail them in early May as dictated by state statute," Duncan said in a press released. "It is important that taxpayers know when to expect their real estate tax bill and to be able to plan accordingly."

Taxes may be paid online under the Treasurer tab at vermilioncounty.org; in person at the county administration building, 201 N. Vermilion, Danville; mailing payment to P.O. Box

Foodmobile to hold distribution at Rossville Church of Christ

Eastern Illinois Foodbank will distribute a truckload of food from the Eastern Illinois Foodbank to hungry area families. The distribution will be held from 10-11:30 a.m. Saturday at Rossville Church of Christ, 514 E. Attica.

All county residents who meet income eligibility criteria are welcome (see chart). Those attending are asked to bring boxes or bags to transport food.

The event is part of the foodbank's Foodmobile program, mobile food pantries bringing nutritious

food to areas of chronic or extreme need.

The distribution comes at a critical moment for area residents. Data released by Feeding America, the nation's network of food banks, shows 14% of people in eastern Illinois are considered food insecure, which means they sometimes lack adequate access to food. Nearly 20% of children are food insecure.

All eligible residents of Vermilion County who are in need of food and grocery product are welcome to attend the Foodmobile distribution.

To be eligible, a household must have an income at or below 185% of the federal poverty level, or approximately \$3,793 per month for a family of four. Full eligibility criteria are listed in the chart.
