2 a.m. storm runs through city leaving little major damage

A line of strong thunderstorms moved through east central Illinois early Thursday morning, sparing Hoopeston from extensive damage.

The storm moved through at about 2 a.m., with high winds and brief but torrential rain. Power outages were reported on the city's south side.

Residents awakened to find branches downed, and in some cases, trees. A tree on McKinley split in the storm with half blocking the back entrance to a house and the other half falling on a car.

By 8 a.m., many residents had debris placed curbside, waiting to be picked up by Street and Alley Department workers.

Debris affected other city departments, as Parks and Cemetery workers cleared limbs and branches that had fallen. Water Department workers, who had the pool in sparkling shape for opening day, spent Thursday morning cleaning leaves and sticks from the water.
