

Firefighters from Rankin, Hoopeston and Cissna Park were called to the three-story building located in the 200 block of East Johnson and West Second Ave.

Hoopeston firemen were called at 4:21 a.m. and cleared the scene at 6:15 a.m.

The cause of the fire was not immediately known. A report from the Fire Marshal's investigator may be weeks away.

The former school has been a point of contention for several years. Owner Herbert Polchow was fined \$500 after being found guilty last December on an ordinance violation relating to the building's deterioration.

Earlier this year, the village board heard residents' concerns about he building's condition during a public hearing. Officials considered the structure a potential health and safety concern, as well as an eyesore.
