Bennett updates residents on legislative action at meeting

A group of area residents got a firsthand report on recent state government action at a meeting with state Rep. Tom Bennett (R-106) Thursday.

Bennett met with constituents at Hoopeston City Hall to review legislation that sailed through the legislature, thanks to the Democrats' super majority.

That legislation included an expanded abortion bill that declares abortion a "fundamental right"; higher taxes and fees on gasoline, vehicle registration, trucking registration and others; legalizing recreational marijuana, then creating a licensing fee to sell it, as well as a tax when purchased; a \$1 per-pack increase in the cigarette tax, licensing for casino expansion and

Gary Weinard, who served as Grant Township Road Commissioner and Vermilion County Board chairman, said the state should look at its regulations concerning projects. The state will pay \$1 million to rebuild a small bridge, but will not pay to use clean anhydrous tanks as culverts. "That tank will still be her in 100 years." he said.
