# Eyes turn skyward for Balloons Over Vermilion this weekend

All eyes will be focused on the skies Friday and Saturday for Balloons Over Vermilion.

Held at the Vermilion Regional Airport in Danville, the event will be open from 3 p.m. to 10 p.m. Friday. Saturday's events start at 6:30 a.m. with a community flight, weather permitting. Gates at the airport will be open from 1 p.m.-10:30 p.m.

Tethered balloon rides will be available from 6:30-10 p.m. both evenings. Balloon launches will be held at 6:30 p.m. Friday and Saturday, followed by balloon glows from 8:30-9 p.m. Laser light shows will be held both days beginning at 9:15 p.m.

Several bands will perform during the weekend,

including Jordan & Jill. American Pie. The Freakness, Crazv Johnny Band, Boss Hogg & The Good Ol' Boys, Dable Allen Band, Cobalt, Double Dots and House of Cards.

The Kids Zone will be open from 3-10:30 p.m. Friday and 1-10:30 p.m. Saturday. The zone will feature inflatables, joyful

bubbles, face painting, free lawn games and Touch-A-Truck. There is a fee for inflatables of one to three tickets, depending on the feature. Tickets are \$1 each or 24 for \$20. Inflatables will be free from 1-3 p.m. Saturday only.

Saturday-only activities include a classic car show, sand volleyball tournament and archery demonstration and lessons.

The festival's primary benefactor will be honored both evenings. Julius W. Hegeler II, instrumental in the event's startup, died July 5 at age 91. The national anthem will be dedicated to him both nights, as will a flyover of a Texan T-6 Warbird at 5:45 p.m. Friday.

The Julius W. Hegeler II Foundation is the title sponsor of the festival. When Balloons Over Vermilion was started, Mr. Hegeler made a five-year pledge \$100,000. The event is in its fourth year.

Admission is \$5 per person. Children 10 and younger are admitted free with each paid adult.

Parking is \$5 per vehicle and \$25 per RV. Motorists may enter off of West Newell, east of Bowman. Free shuttle bus rides will be available from the Walmart and Lowe's parking lots. Shuttles will run continuously from 2:30 p.m.-10:30 p.m. both days.
