Board approves Maple boiler package at special meeting

The clock is ticking on replacing Maple School's boiler. In a 5-0 vote, Hoopeston Area School Board on Monday approved a \$670,324 package with McKinstry Company to design and engineer the project, as well as oversee the entire process.

Board members Lisa Leigh and Rich Eisenmann were absent from Monday's special meeting.

Of the \$670,324, \$401,834 is for two boilers, labor, materials, bond and insurance. The Lochinvar boilers will be purchased and installed by Reliable Mechanical Co., of Champaign.

Another \$113,854 will go towards engineering and related costs and \$33,684 has been earmarked for contin-



gencies, such as the possibility that electrical service may need to be upgraded for the new boilers. Whatever contingency money is not needed will be returned to the district. The final \$120,952 is for McKinstry overhead and prof-

The cost is significantly less than the \$1.1 million projected cost in a 2018 HVAC assessment done by Mattoon -based Upchurch Group architectural firm, and slightly less than the hoped-for \$700,000-\$800,000 figure hoped for by the district.

The project includes removing two boilers currently at Maple and installing new ones in a 12-week time frame, with a push to get work done so that teachers and students will not be affected when students return to the classrooms on August 19.

In other action, the board unanimously approved spending \$167,000 with Technology Resources for 500 Chromebooks, as part of the district's one-on-one technology program and \$28,538.44 for 28 Dell desktop computers.

The board will meet in regular session at 6 p.m. Thursday in the high school library.
