## Hoopeston Area schools to hold 2019-20 registration next week

Hoopeston Area schools will register students for the 2019-20 year next Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

### Tuesday, Aug. 6

• Registration for middle school and high school will be held from 8:30-11 a.m. and 12:30-3:30 p.m. in their respective buildings.

### Wednesday, Aug. 7

• Maple will hold registration from 1-6 p.m. for ECSE and grades K-2.

• John Greer will register grades 3-5 from 1-6 p.m.

• Middle and high school registration will be held from 8:30-11 a.m. and 1-6 p.m. in their respective buildings.

### Thursday, Aug. 8

• High school registration will be held from 8:30-11 a.m. and 12:30-3:30 p.m.

• Orientation for freshmen and their parents will be from 6-6:45 p.m. in the high school auditorium.

• Previous pre-K students may register at Maple from 1-6 p.m. New pre-K students must be screened before they are registered.

Fees for the upcoming year are:

- Early Childhood \$20 book rental
- K-12 \$50 book rental
- MS/HS Activity Fee \$20/activity, max. \$40/student, \$80 per family

High school fees due at registration include:

- \$50 driver education fee for all ninth graders
- \$5 for Spanish I, II and III students for online workbook
- \$12 for a weekly magazine for Government classes
- \$10 for CPE/AED training in Health classes

## Newly implemented parking pass to be required for HAHS students, staff for 2019-20 school year

Beginning this year, all Hoopeston Area High School students and staff who wish to park on school grounds must purchase a \$10 parking pass.

Student parking permits are available and only students issued a HAHS parking permit may park on school property, and only in designated student parking areas, during the school day.

Passes are assigned to the student, not the vehicle. Designed to hang from the rearview mirror, they are easily transferable from one vehicle to another.

Students who miss their bus and drive to school will not be allowed to park on campus without a parking permit. Students who lose their parking permit must pay an additional \$10 for a replacement.

Parking permits will be available at registration. After that, students may purchase them at the main office or dean's office.

Parking pass recipients are required to follow all driving regulations, the Student Discipline Policy and all rules that apply. Failure to do so will result in forfeiting the privilege of parking on school property and will not receive a refund of the parking permit fee.
