## Lacy to seek reelection as county state's attorney in March 2020

DANVILLE—Vermilion County State's Attorney Jacqueline Lacy on Thursday announced her intent to seek reelection in March 2020.

In November 2016, Lacy, a Republican, was elected as the county's first woman's state's attorney after serving six years as the county's first woman chief public defender.

Lacy said she has built a strong office of talented prosecutors and staff that successfully prosecute murderers and violent sexual criminals. In all criminal prosecutions, Lacy and her staff stand to seek justice, secure convictions and protect victims' rights.

"One of the reasons I have been successful is because I have also worked in the DuPage, Kane, Kendall and

Cook County court systems," Lacy said. "I understand the law and the defense tactics used. I understand urban crime and gangs and I am able to bring that wealth of knowledge and experience to the citizens of Vermilion County."
