Burglars strike several Hoopeston businesses, Rossville eatery

Hoopeston police are investigating four burglaries/ attempted burglaries, most reported Sunday morning. An employee of Henning's Root Beer Stand, 411 S. Dixie Hwy., called police at 4:27 a.m. Officers arrived to find a broken window and the cash register on the floor.

At 9:29 a.m., police were called to Fun for All Miniature Golf, in McFerren Park, after the building owner discovered damage to the windows. Sunday was to

be the golf course's last day of the season.

At 10:56 a.m., a city maintenance worker found the door to the Girl Scout House ajar. Police found parts of the building had been damaged and the building entered.

The final report was made at 7:14 p.m., when police were sent to the 300 block of West Elm regarding a burglary.
