City Council is expected to discuss demolishing the disintegrating structure. City council to consider demolishing Market St. eyesore

A once grand brick building may be in line for the wrecking ball.

The multi-story building at 204 N. Market, which formerly housed the Longfellow Insurance Agency, was set to be offered at Thursday's tax trustee auction. Wednesday, at a special "committee of the whole" meeting of the council, agreed that the structure should be pulled from the list of properties to be sold at the auction.

Mayor Bill Crusinberry was joined at the meeting by aldermen Alex Houmes, Carl Ankenbrand, Robin Lawson and Lourdine Florek.

With the building pulled from the sale, the council is scheduled to discuss demolishing it. Crusinberry said he received a "firm quote" from an area contractor to raze the building, bury the bricks on site and take debris to the landfill. He did not release the See EYESORE on other side

amount of the quote because officials will have to seek buds for the work, which would "give other people an unfair advantage" if the contractor's figures were released. He did estimate the total project at \$50,000 or less, depending on the level of asbestos remediation needed.

Concerning the burned out structure at 520 E. Honeywell, Crusinberry said it is currently tied up in a bankruptcy.

The former Dyer home burned August 28, 2015 and has been vacant since then.
